The Republic of Croatia *has received* financing in the amount of US\$ **24.7 million** equivalent from the World Bank toward the cost of the additional financing of INTEGRATED LAND ADMINISTRATION SYSTEM PROJECT (ILAS Project) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, non-consulting services and consulting services to be procured under this project. This project will be jointly financed by the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) and State Geodetic Administration (SGA).

The project will include the following components:

A. Land Registration System Development - Component A focuses on the services provided by Land Registry Management Service within the Ministry of Justice through 107 Land Registration Offices (LRO). The sub-components are: A.1. Digital Archive (goods, services and works), A.5. Relocation of the Zagreb LRO (goods, services and works) and A.6. Operational Improvement of Under-performing LROs (services).

B. Spatial Information and Cadastre System Modernization - Component B is to improve the quality and presentation of spatial and cadastral data managed and maintained by SGA, and to implement a National Spatial Data Infrastructure (NSDI) program. The sub-components are: B.1. Digital Archive (goods and services), B.2. Support for restructuring of the SGA (works, goods and services), B.3. Cadastre System Modernization (goods) and B.4. Support to Other Datasets (goods and services)

C. Improving Digital Services - Component C will finance technical assistance, software development and technical services for data quality improvement. The sub-components are: C.1. Data quality improvement (non-consultancy and services), C.2. Joint Information System (JIS) further development (goods and services) and C.4. Support to the Joint cadastral and land registry strategy implementation (goods and services).

D. Project Management, Training and Public Awareness – Component D will support PIU, public awareness campaigns and a customer satisfaction survey. Sub-components are: D.1. Project Management (services and goods), D.2. Training and Education Activities (services) and D.3. Activities on Public Awareness (services).

Procurement of contracts financed by the World Bank will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016, revised November 2017) (Procurement Regulations)*, and is open to all eligible firms and individuals as defined in the *Procurement Regulations*. After project negotiations, the World Bank shall arrange the publication on its external website of the agreed initial procurement plan and all subsequent updates once it has provided a no objection.

Specific procurement notices for contracts subject to open international competitive procurement will be announced, as they become available, in *UN Development Business* online, on the World Bank's external website and on free-access web site of the ILAS Project www.uredjenazemlja.hr and in official gazette "Narodne novine".

Prequalification/Initial Selection of suppliers and contractors is not anticipated.
